Fairchild Farm

26 Lees Hill Road

Fairchild Farm located at 26 Lee's Hill Road is a classic vernacular farmhouse of which the oldest part was built around 1750 by Joseph Fairchild (1724-1804) in what was then called Passaic Township. It has the traditional 1 ½ story, 1 story, lean-to progression of early New Jersey houses. The present owners, John and Sally Quinn have added a historically appropriate garage, two small additions, and a northern version of a Williamsburg style garden off the house. Fairchild Farm located at 26 Lee's Hill Road is on the state and national registers of historic places.
